The following amendments to Part V – Fire Protection – 2013, have been introduced:

1. *Sub-paragraph .46 of paragraph 1.3.3 has been amended to read:*
 - .46** components of fixed fire detection and alarm systems for accommodation and service spaces, control stations, machinery spaces and unattended machinery spaces (control and indicating devices, electrical and electronic installations, power supply equipment, fire detectors: smoke detectors, heat detectors and flame detectors, manually operated call points as well as short circuit isolators, input/output devices, cables);

 2. *In paragraph 1.3.3, the following sub-paragraphs have been added:*
 - .49** sample extraction smoke systems (control and indicating equipment, electrical and electronic installations, power supply equipment, aspirating smoke detectors);
 - .50** C class divisions;
 - .51** fixed hydrocarbon gas detection systems;
 - .52** evacuation guidance systems used as an alternative to low-location lighting systems (applicable on passenger ships).

 3. *In paragraph 1.3.5, sub-paragraphs: .1, .8, .20 and .34 have been deleted and other sub-paragraphs have been renumbered accordingly.*
